"Fuses ain't Fuses"

As many will know the electrical components in our cars are protected by fuses - mostly mounted in a convenient fuse distribution centre (fuse box). These are rated with reference to the component and wiring size utilized in the particular cct being protected and the current draw down. The fuses can be small plug in units made from glass or plastic casings, or you could have "self resetting" cct breakers (little oblong metal cans), these are used on high current ccts like electric windows, where there is the possibility of a temporary obstruction (a stupid arm out the window) which could overload the cct for a brief second, replacing fuses would be a tedium, but a cct breaker would open, save the cct and after it cools down - reset.

However, there is a third type, the "Fusible Wire Link" these are designed to protect a wiring loom from overload meltdown and the resultant fire - fires in a Corvette are not good, in fact on the miss a heartbeat and the Sphinctor scales, they are terrifying. Now over the years, ratings, wire and fuse sizes have changed, also a lot of components draw far less current, but as far as C4's are concerned from 84 thru 96 a lot more electronic's and electrically driven components have been designed into our cars for a better driving experience. But still early days, ergo some units like cooling fans draw heaps of juice on start up and maybe 25Amps on run. Whilst the wiring knitted into covered looms is rated to handle the current, it is also rated to handle a lot more, right up to the red hot stage followed by the "smoke" stage, then the burning car inferno stage.

To elleviate this issue the wiring looms are divided up and loom wiring sizes rated to the required specs, but to protect each smaller loom or cct, a "Fusible wire Link" is connected between power source and the start of the loom circuit. Now as the name suggests a Fusible wire Link is just a piece wire, but it's sealed in a non flamable covering and as a rule of thumb the Fuse is always "4" wire sizes smaller than the cct it protects.

Therefore a loom of 16ga wiring is protected by a fuse 4 sizes smaller - which is 20ga - YES not a misprint, the larger the number wire guage, the smaller the wire diametre ergo 14ga loom requires 18ga fuse.

There is also other magic at play, the length of the fuse, but we wont go into the complicated maths required to determine that figure, but rule of thumb states that links are not to excede 8".

Basically the link can carry all the rquired current used by each component on the feed, in the "all on" case scenario there maybe a chance of heating up a little. However, upon a short cct or a fan melt down, the loom current will peak rapidly, the link which is smaller represents a series impedance (ie. a bottle neck to current) and it will reach fussion temperature much quicker and melt, severing the cct, but because it is in a nonflamable covering, there are no fires, in fact it is sometimes very hard to even see the link has fused as there is no visible burning or discoloration on the link.

Most links in C4's are 2.5"~ 5" in length, for instance links "D & E" are ~ 3" whilst "H" is ~ 4.5" and most are rated 20ga, NOW in the advent you blow one, best of luck getting any 20ga - there are plenty of 14, 16, 18 gauge fuses available, I had to get some recently from the US, I could find no 20ga here.

And before you suggest puting two in parallel, there is a raft of sience that says "your car is now doomed".

Basically you're safe if you fix the cause of the fault and replace like fuse for like fuse, ALSO some links have numbers stamped or moulded into them - mine had a "20" on them - first thoughts were "easy peasy" this is a 20 Amp fuse, but alas it's not 20 Amps but 20 gauge.

It would be safe to say that unless interferred with, most owners would never be confronted with issues around fusible links and if in doubt see a quality Auto Electrician. A blown link is indicative of a major component or cable fault, always fix the "Cause" first before just changing links or even small fuses, these components don't blow for no reason.






