






The weather was a lot cooler after the previous day's heatwave, but only a few drops of rain which was good.




Not really the results that everyone was hoping for, especially after a successful 2025 season!



From the Trea\$ury

Nov - Dec - Jan Treas Report.

Not much happening over this period, the main investment account is still locked up till approx Mar'26 and stands at \$26,150.05.

The everyday account stands at \$50,157.16 and has been increased by the addition of the CNC25 accounts, which are now closed although I have two "Trophies" still to be delivered to their winners.

Other issues that arose were when I tried to open a new investment account, and was hit with Bank/Gov regulations that have changed and been tightened since the last time we updated our Accounts. We needed to remove all old signatories (esp the deceased ones), put new ones on, which required our team jumping thru hoops, presenting ID's etc etc all in the face of the coming Xmas.

As I type this, the bank fixes are still not completed, but hopefully will be done by the Feb meeting.

NOW! Why all these issues, well at the conclusion of our very successful CNC25 Convention at Parkes, a great convention which was costed a long time before the event at the "Then Current Costs", however, due to the great due diligence and extreme hard work, our team managed to reduce costs, esp for apparel, trophies, wine.... you name it, just about everything, add to this the tenacious and dogged pleading of one of our team who managed to gain approx \$15K from several eager sponsors. As a result your management team has directed me to squirrel away in a bag in the StG Vault the unused funds (~\$31K), ready and exclusively for the use of our next Convention some years away.

Now I'm sure there are those of you who missed some meetings, but let me re-iterate "yes we made a slightish profit" and no we can't just give it away or donate it, unless it's to a like/similar (automotive) club/group, to this effect on 16th Dec I transferred \$500 to the CNC26 Qld convention as agreed by all clubs.

We are governed by rules etc under NSW Law, but I would assume that our next convention will be either over the top elaborate or dead cheap. We operate as a Not for Profit Local Community Sporting Club - it's always important to have a high sounding special sounding name.

As such we can only donate to clubs/entities that are like minded etc - in short to "Car Clubs" ergo to any Car club, but especially Corvette Car Clubs - these are NSW Rules and may not apply to other state Vette Clubs.

Two new members this month, a Mr. Leigh Walters 73 of Merewether and Mr. Daniel James 82 Castle Cove. As usual if you have any queries then please see me at a run or meeting or drop me a line. Regards.


