





This month I will not prattle on about "H" Plates as I've done now for several months, I'm sure the rules for "H" Plates is now well and truly understood.

Finances. The club's investment account has finally matured and gained the princely amout of \$103.27 which was earned at the phenominal rate of 0.25%pa.

At the time of writing this report I have an appointment with St.George to discuss re-investment and what rates are now available, with this decision to be completed by 9th October, 2022. I have no idea at this time of what the rates may be, but I'm pretty sure I will not re-invest for a 12 month period, since rates now seem to be on the move. This account closes at \$41,411.04.

The everday account opened August at \$5,799.20 and closed at \$6,158.90 with credits of \$1735 from renewals, new Memberships and \$800 from advertisers Keen & Corvette Central whilst debits of \$880 Printing, \$141.18 Post and \$354.17 made up of WEB/IT, account cost (\$20), Raffles tea/coffee, although our new meeting site has kindly supplied tea & coffee, but of course the club will supply some cake/biscuits etc on the meeting night. Whilst the account closed as per above it stands at \$6437.72 (26 September)




